President Graybill called the Convention to order at 9:10 a.m.

Invocation was given by Delegate Arbanas. All members were present on roll call except Delaney and Felt, who were excused.

At this time Delegate Dahood rose on a Point of Personal Privilege and stated he wished to respond to a recent news article. Mr. Dahood made the following statement:

"It is totally beyond legal logic for anyone to contend that the Bill of Rights Proposal has an effect on the "no-fault insurance" concept.

There is absolutely no way that such a conclusion can be reached by a fair, sound thinking person.

The present attack on that section of the Bill of Rights, which only restores to an injured working man in certain situations his right to full legal redress, is unfair, unjust and in many respects dishonest.

For a number of weeks this section of the Bill of Rights has been discussed, debated and circulated. Not a single critic of the section was able to seriously contend that this section prohibited the legislature from considering no-fault insurance in the future.

This section was fully debated by the Convention and before that at a public committee hearing after proper notice was posted.

Who is behind this unfair, unjust and improper campaign to induce the delegates to reject this section on final vote? There is no way to answer the unfair statements in Convention Hall as the issue cannot now be debated before final vote.

If these few critics are so right in their position, where were they when we had a number of public committee hearings on this issue? For more than 6 weeks this has been an open issue. Now that debate and discussion is permanently closed by Convention rules stories are released to the press attacking that section of the Bill of Rights.

All that is involved is a basic constitutional right concerning an injured working man. He will have restored to him a basic fundamental right to full justice which he had for more than 80 years before last year's court decision.

No fault insurance is not involved, cannot be involved and any contention to the contrary is not only unfair and unjust but, and I say this advisedly, a big lie."

At the conclusion of his statement, Delegate Dahood requested that the following addition be made to the "COMMENTS" to the Bill of Rights Committee proposal on page 31 after the word "negligent" in line 12: "Further, it is the intent of the Committee that the additional wording shall not be construed to preclude the adoption of a no-fault insurance plan for the State of Montana." There was no objection and the Chair instructed that the Journal so show.
